



## Anna E. Bradley (Burdette)

July 18, 1929 - October 21, 2020

Anna E. Bradley (Burdette) transitioned to her heavenly home on October 21, 2020, she was 91. She was a caregiver by nature and a devoted nurse by profession. She worked at several local hospitals including Red Cross Hospital, St. Joseph's Infirmary and Children's Hospital where she was a member of the surgical team that performed the first pediatric open-heart procedure in Kentucky. She also worked proudly as the nurse at the former Shawnee Jr. High School and retired from the Park-Duvalle Neighborhood Health Center.

Anna was devoted to her family. She was always ready to provide support, aid or a listening ear to anyone in need. She was a prolific letter writer, a quick wit, and the baker of the world's best caramel cakes.

Anna was preceded in death by her father, Chester Burdette, her mother, the former Anna May Van Buren, her sister, Dorothy May Cook and her niece Zondra E. Curtis.
