



## Billy Snow (Southeast)

January 13, 1944 - May 3, 2026

Billy Snow passed away peacefully surrounded by family at the University of Louisville hospital downtown on May 3, 2026.

Billy was born in Louisville, Ky on January 13, 1944. He served his country as an Airman in the United States Air Force and was stationed in Udon Thani, Thailand in the late 1960's. It was in Thailand that he met and married his wife Chavantee. They were married for 57 years and together opened the Thai Cafe in Louisville in 1996. The restaurant thrived for 28 years and is still remembered fondly by their many patrons. Billy worked for the United States Postal Services for 37 years and was a proud graduate of Kentucky State University.
