STEWART, Suffragan Bishop Eugene J., 80, transitioned from labor to reward in glory on Tuesday, March 21, 2017. The youngest son of four children, Bishop Stewart was born on October 22, 1936 in Detroit, Michigan to John and Mamie Stewart. His pastoralship expands from Albuquerque, New Mexico for 15 years and 25 years in Louisville, Kentucky. He leaves to cherish his memory, his beloved wife of nearly 55 years – Lady Elaine Stewart, his daughter, Eugenia Clairdy (Lawrence); son, Victor Stewart (Arlene) and brother, Dist. Eld.
