Chavantee Snow passed away peacefully surrounded by family in her home in Louisville, Ky. on May 23, 2025.

Chavantee was born in Bangkok, Thailand and met Billy Snow in the spring of 1967 in Udon Thani. They married the following year and moved to Louisville, KY. Chavantee opened the Thai Cafe in 1994 with her husband Billy, one of the first Thai restaurants in Louisville, KY. The restaurant thrived for 28 years and is still remembered fondly by her many loyal patrons.

She is survived by her husband Billy Snow; 3 children, Ahtitya Snow, Vichan Snow (Asher) and Thida Snow; 1 grandchild, Julianne "Rhorey" Snow; 3 sisters, Tawaree Santadsomruajkarn, Chaveewan Santadsomruajkarn, and Varitha Suwanpradit, and 1 brother, Anon Somruajkarn.
