Delphia Elizabeth Robinson, Ph.D., a Romance language scholar and teacher and a non-smoker, died April 13, 2015, of metastatic lung cancer at the Yale-New Haven Smilow Cancer Hospital in New Haven, Connecticut.

Dr. Robinson was born April 29, 1946, in Louisville, Kentucky. She was the first child of Adam M. Robinson, Sr., M.D., now deceased, and Addie Hilda Brown Robinson, who survives.
