Doris Marie Sibit was born in Mound Bayou, MS on May 17, 1927 to parents Douglas Simpson and Mamie Jordan Burton. She led a very active life and at the age of 90 she entered into New Life on Friday, December 8. She was a loving mother, mother-in-law, auntie, grandmother, great grandmother and a good friend to so many.

When Doris was two years old her family moved to Hughes, AR. At the age of 11 she was baptized Baptist. In the 1960s Doris became Catholic.
