DR. SAMUEL G. EUBANKS, JR., 72, of Louisville, passed away Wednesday, December 11, 2013.

Originally from Memphis, TN, Dr. Eubanks was a devoted husband and father who provided 37 years of service to the Commonwealth of Kentucky. He served on the board of Park DuValle Community Health Center, was a member of the Meharry Medical College Alumni Association, was a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, and was named Kentucky Colonel in 2004.

Dr. Eubanks will be fondly remembered for his pleasant disposition, caring nature, and his generosity.

Dr. Eubanks is survived by his loving wife of 48 years Hazel P. Eubanks; daughter Monica L. Eubanks; son Samuel G. Eubanks III (Tamekia); four sisters and four brothers.
