



Harris W. Jenkins, Sr.

Harris W. Jenkins, Sr., 72 years old, died March 22, 2020 at Norton Audubon Hospital after a battle with heart failure.

He was born in Pulaski, Tennessee, the son of William Jenkins, Sr. and Gertrude Marks Jenkins.

After graduating from Giles County High, Harris joined the Army in which he served two years in Vietnam where he received a Purple Heart during his service. He attended the Performing Arts College in Pulaski Tn.

After two previous marriages, Harris and current wife Evelyn have been blessed to have been together for 35 years. They reside in Louisville Ky. Harris worked various jobs over the years but retired from International Harvester where he worked at the Louisville and Indianapolis plants retiring after 30 years. His last position held was in quality control.
