



Harvey Louis Langford (SOUTHEAST)

August 16, 1935 - September 8, 2024

Harvey Louis Langford was born in Brownsville, Tennessee on August 16th, 1935 to the late William H. Langford and Ollie Mae Langford. He entered into his eternal rest surrounded by his family and loved ones on Sunday, September 8th, 2024 in Louisville, Kentucky. In addition to his mother and father, Harvey was preceded in death by his faithful wife Ann Slaton Langford, brothers Willie Langford and Benjamin Langford and his sisters, Edmonia Langford, Dorothy Langford, Setorias Marshall and Hattie Blanton. He spent his formative years in Mayfield Kentucky and was a 1953 graduate of Dunbar High School in Mayfield. After high school, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served his country honorably for four years. After completing his enlistment, he enrolled in Murray State University and graduated in 1962 with a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting. After graduating from college he started a career as a Revenue Agent with the Internal Revenue Service in Louisville, KY.

Over the course of his 33 year career with the IRS, Harvey rose from Revenue Agent to the Chief of Appeals. After retiring from the Federal Government in 1995, he worked part-time as a real estate agent for many years. Harvey was a proud Life member of Kappa Alpha Psi (Louisville Alumni Chapter). He was also a member of the Prospect Optimist Club.

Harvey leaves to cherish his memory three children, Lisa, William and Elizabeth Langford (Kindu Franklin); one brother, Van Langford, two sisters, Virginia Langford, and Judy Browne (Steve); four grandsons, Michael Turpin,

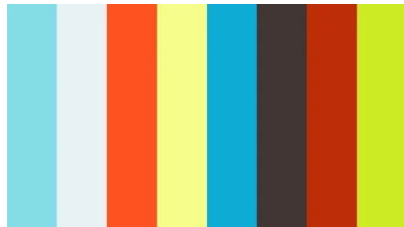
