Howard A. Duncan, 63, passed away Saturday, September 4, 2021.

He was a member of Beargrass Baptist Church. He graduated from Shawnee High School. Howard was well-known throughout Louisville and regarded as the all-time leading scorer of The Dirt Bowl. He was a point guard for the 1976-77 University of Tennessee at Chattanooga NCAA Division Two National Championship Team.
