December 1, 1971 - February 10, 2021

Mr. Tyrran Wayne Scroggins, 49, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, February 10, 2021. He was a graduate of the University of Louisville, and a dedicated educator in the city of Louisville. He was a passionate educator, leader, and mentor and for this, his legacy will live on forever. He was the first African American coach to win a High School State Football Championship in Kentucky.

He is survived by his parents, William and Yvonne Richardson; children, Jayden, Jordan, and Mikayla Scroggins; fiancée Sheri Duff; sisters, Tara Glass, Reverend Danielle Richardson, and Felisha Richardson; niece Taryn Glass; nephew Antonio McNeill, as well as a host of extended family and friends.
